- Since 2003, WXAV 88.3FM has won over two dozen Illinois Broadcasting Association Student Silver Dome Awards, including first place in "Best Radio Live Sports Broadcast," "Best Radio Aircheck," and "Best Radio Newscast."
- In 2022, WXAV won first place in the Intercollegiate Broadcasting System's Golden Microphone Award for "Best Underwriting Spot."
- WXAV won second place in the Illinois Broadcasting Association's Professional Silver Dome Awards for a series titled "Veteran Matters."
- WXAV was named by the Chicago Tribune and Paste Magazine as one of the best alternative and college radio stations in Chicago and the country.
